Whether you're an avid birder working on your life list or someone who just enjoys spotting interesting birds, the Mesilla Valley has plenty of opportunities for bird watchers.

Aguirre Spring Campground, on the east side of the Organ Mountains, accessed from U.S. 70. 575-525-4300.

Dripping Springs Natural Area, 10 miles east of Interstate 25, Exit 1, on the western edge of the Organ Mountains. 575-522-1219.

Leasburg Dam State Park, 15 miles north of Las Cruces on I-25 near Fort Selden State Monument. 575-524-4068.
