1.6 SCHOOL HOURS MIDDLE SCHOOL

The following are the 2015-2016 school hours for Middle School students. Students are to arrive no earlier than 7:30am and no later than 8:00am. Classes begin promptly at 8:00 am, therefore we expect all students to be on time. Students entering after 8:00am must report to the office for admittance into class and must be signed in by a parent or adult. Students are released at 3:00pm. Middle school students need to be picked up by 3:15pm. The only middle school students who are allowed to be on campus after 3:15 must be in a supervised after school program, or structured study hall. Students may not be left unsupervised on the SODA campus.

1.7 SCHOOL HOURS HIGH SCHOOL

The following are the 2015-2016 school hours for High School students. High School classes begin at 9:00 am and end at 4:00 pm. Students who arrive earlier must be in a structured before school class or supervised study hall. Students entering after 9:00am must sign in at the office for admittance. Students are released at 4:00pm. High school students need to vacate the campus by 4:14 unless they are in a supervised after school program, credit recovery, or structured study hall. Students may not be unsupervised on the SODA campus.

1.8 SCHOOL HOURS EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL
