DRESS CODE

The following will be the acceptable dress code for SODA. All students must adhere to this policy. Students will be required to wear the dress uniform every school day. Special dress down opportunities will be announced. The dress code is part of the School of Dreams Academy mission and vision to prepare students for academic and social success. Therefore, if students and/or guardians are unwilling to comply with the dress code policy, students will be subject to appropriate disciplinary actions.

4.41 Required:

- All students will wear a polo shirt with a SODA logo.
- All polo shirts with the logo will be purchased through School of Dreams Academy approved vendors.
- Polos with the logo purchased prior to 2015-2016 year will be acceptable until 2017.
- The polo must be visible at all times from the beginning of school day until school ends. For example, hoodies, and sweaters must either have the SODA logo or be underneath the polo shirt. Jackets can be any style, but must be removed in class so that the polo and logo is plainly visible.

1.44 Polo shirts may not be altered (cut, tied, sewn, ect) and fit appropriately. Acceptable pants and shorts will be as follows for the 2015-2016 school year. Pants, shorts and skirts can be Docker style, cargo, carpenter or jeans in solid colors (no plaid, or other patterns). Colors are limited to black, blue or khaki. No clothing with holes and rips in them will be allowed. Shorts and skirts must be worn no higher than two inches above the knee. No Slippers or Bed time attire allowed at SODA.

1.45 Dress Down Days will vary and specific guidelines will be announced depending on the occasion.

SODA Administration has final say on all dress code issues.
